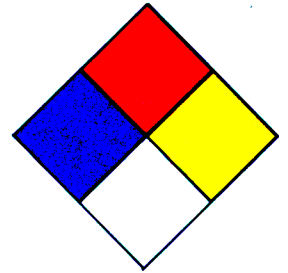

# PESTICIDES

(mixed packaged products only)



Liquids or wettable powders, dusts, granules; diverse chemical types. (Excluding—gaseous fumigants (Class 2), chlorates (Class 5.1) and acrolein, which each require segregated storage.)

## HAZARDS

Refer to container labels for details and safety directions. Contents may burn and/or explode producing harmful smoke or vapour.

Keep away from heat and naked flames.

Poisoning may result from skin and eye contact, breathing or swallowing. Skin contact presents the greatest danger.

May be corrosive.

Environmental hazard—contain spillage.

## SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

### STORAGE

Store in well-ventilated area, as cool as possible, isolated from non-pesticides and away from naked flame and ignition sources.

Store herbicides and veterinary chemicals separately from each other and other pesticides to prevent cross-contamination in the event of leakage.

Check that containers are clearly LABELLED.

Where product cannot be identified, do not sell or use.

Consult possible suppliers for advice.

Periodically inspect stock for leaking or damaged containers.

Ensure 'No Smoking' and restricted entry signs are displayed.

Display phone numbers of ambulance, hospital/doctor and fire brigade.

Check protective and safety equipment and clean-up gear regularly and keep in clean and working condition.

Keep access clear to exits and to emergency equipment.

Keep site free of vegetation and rubbish.

### HANDLING

Wear PVC gloves, coveralls and safety footwear when handling intact containers.

Wash hands before eating, smoking, drinking or using toilet and immediately after loading or unloading or transferring a shipment of pesticide.

Do not eat, drink or smoke in the storage area.

Inspect vehicles for spills before and after unloading.

Do not release a contaminated vehicle.

Do not touch or wipe your face on protective equipment.

Do not decant in the store.
