## PREFACE

This Standard was prepared by the Standards Australia Committee ME-033, Abrasives, to supersede AS/NZS 4527:1998, *Abrasive sheets—Dimensions, tolerances and designation*.

This Standard is identical with, and has been reproduced from ISO 21948:2001, *Coated abrasives—Plain sheets*.

The objective of this Standard is to provide manufacturers and users of bonded abrasive products with dimensions, tolerances and designations for abrasive sheets intended for use on portable machines or for hand sanding.

The objective of this revision is to adopt the current edition of ISO 21948.

As this Standard is reproduced from an international Standard, the following applies:

- (a) Its number appears on the cover and title page while the International Standard number appears only on the cover.
- (b) In the source test, ‘this International Standard’ should read ‘this Australian Standard’.
- (c) A full point substitutes for a comma when referring to a decimal marker.

References to international Standards should be replaced by equivalent Australian, New Zealand or Australian/New Zealand Standards, as follows:
